AIRFRANCE

Flights from London City and Heathrow available daily but require a change at Paris; those from Heathrow land at Charles de Gaulle airport, then change to Orly airport for the 2nd leg to Brest. Time consuming and expensive - around £320 per person.

eurostar

Let the train take the strain.....

Train travel to Brest is available from London St. Pancras using Eurostar, with one change at Paris but you do also have to change **stations** at Paris which is approximately a 40 min trip by Metro, taxi or bus. The whole journey takes about 8 hrs and tickets are from £115 return per person, but if you're a train fanatic or fancy a lazy day watching the countryside fly past then hey, why not?
